VIEW exhibitions online and in four gallery spaces across campus for free. You'll find these cultural spaces in Old College Hall, Mechanical Hall, Penny Hall and Morris Library.

CREATE video, audio and graphic design projects using multimedia equipment, production studios and specialized software at the Student Multimedia Design Center in Morris Library.
