If you wish to discover if the Library has a particular edition of an item, start by conducting a title search.

For more on searching by title, please see the "Known Item Searching" tutorial.

In this case, though a number of results are returned which may be helpful, only the first result is an exact title match.

This is a 2016 eBook edition of this particular handbook. However, this does not mean that the 2016 eBook edition is the only one held by the UD Library.

Click on "Explore all editions & formats" to view all additional editions, formats or translations of this item. If you are viewing the item's full record, this menu can also be accessed by clicking on "Explore Editions and Formats".

This menu reveals that there are, in fact, many more current editions of this item held here at UD then just the 2016 edition that was shown in the result set.

As always, be sure to check that the University of Delaware Library is listed rather than "Held by other libraries worldwide", which would indicate that we do not have the item at our library.

The editions and formats function is also important if you would like to know if the Library has an item in a different format. For example, let's use this function to determine if the Library has a Blu-Ray copy of the film, "Jaws". The first film that comes up in our results is a DVD. To investigate if there are other formats of this movie click on, "Explore all editions & formats" to see what other formats of this film are available.

From here, you can see that the UD Library holds this film in several different formats. There are many other ways to make DELCAT Discovery work for you.
