

Research Funding Online:

Thursday, June 4, 2009 and Wednesday, August 12, 2009 10:00 a.m.- 11:30 a.m.

These two workshops will focus on Library databases, Foundation Directory Online and COS Funding Opportunties, are used to identify potential funding resources, such as grants from private foundations, corporations and public charities. Introduction to RefWorks:

This workshop will focus on the basic functions of RefWorks. The University of Delaware Library subscribes to RefWorks, a webbased research management system that allows students and researchers to streamline the scholarly writing process. RefWorks is used to create and manage references, export references directly from online databases, and to generate bibliographies or reference lists within seconds. This workshop is open to University of Delaware students, faculty, and staff.

RefWorks Advanced:

Tuesday, June 23, 2009 10:00 a.m.- 11:30 a.m.

This workshop will introduce the advanced functions of RefWorks, including exporting references from research databases and using the Write-N-Cite feature to insert in-text citations and to create bibliographies. Previous attendance at an Introduction to RefWorks workshop or equivalent experience using RefWorks is strongly suggested. This workshop is open to University of Delaware students, faculty, and staff.

Genealogy for Beginners:

Wednesday, June 24, 2009 10:00 a.m. - 11:30 a.m.

This workshop will cover basic genealogy research methods and provides an overview of the finding aids and resources available for those who are new to genealogy or beginning work on a family tree. Participants are invited to bring family member names to research during the workshop. This workshop is open to University of Delaware students, faculty, staff, and the general public.

What's in a Name? Tips on Searching for Personal Names in Genealogical Resources

Tuesday, July 28, 2009 10:00 a.m. - 11:30 a.m.

This workshop will discuss some of the common challenges faced by researchers, and will offer strategies to overcome these challenges.
