**RefWorks: Complete** provides an overview of both the basic functions of *RefWorks*, as well as more advanced functions such as using the Write-N-Cite feature to insert in-text citations and create bibliographies.

**RefWorks: Beyond the Basics** covers the advanced functions of *RefWorks*, including using the Write-N-Cite feature to insert in-text citations and create bibliographies or reference lists.

**Introduction to ARTstor** features the basic functions of *ARTstor*, a digital library of more than one million images in the areas of art, the humanities and the social sciences.

**Grants for the Nonprofit Organization** focuses upon two Library databases, *Foundation Directory Online* and *COS Funding Opportunities*, which nonprofit organizations can use to identify potential funding sources.

**Research Funding Online** focuses upon two Library databases, *Foundation Directory Online* and *COS Funding Opportunities*, which faculty, staff and graduate students can use to identify potential funding resources.
