Reference Assistance

Utilizing an extensive collection of online and print resources, reference librarians help graduate students find specialized material to support their research. They answer questions in person or by phone, email, chat or text. Reference librarians can direct students to a variety of databases that support graduate-level research. Subject Specialists

Subject specialist librarians meet by appointment with graduate students to discuss appropriate resources for research or coursework. They develop research guides that identify discipline-specific print and online resources.

Library Instruction

Librarians regularly provide instruction to classes taught by graduate students. Library instruction sessions provide students with an overview of research tools and strategies to help them successfully complete class assignments. Reference librarians collaborate with instructors to establish goals and content for library instruction, tailoring the content to student assignments. Special Collections, Student Multimedia Design Center and Film and Video Collection librarians also provide specialized instruction.

Student Multimedia Design Center

The Student Multimedia Design Center is designed for University of Delaware students, faculty and staff to work individually or in groups on the creation of multimedia, including digital video, audio, graphics and web design. Laptops, iPads, cameras, hard drives, lighting kits, mic kits and more are available for check out. There are over 70 computers. Six studios can be reserved for multimedia work in two-hour time blocks. Instructors may reserve Room A or B for hands-on computer instruction sessions or a GroupLink table for classroom collaboration. www.lib.udel.edu/multimedia

Graduate Student Carrels

The Morris Library has locked carrels available to be assigned to graduate students. The carrels are assigned for one academic year and may be renewed. Groups of two or more University of Delaware students may reserve any of the group study rooms in the Morris Library for collaboration or study. DELICAT Discovery

DELICAT Discovery provides information about and access to the physical and electronic holdings of the University of Delaware Library. DELICAT Discovery offers links to e-journals, e-books and other resources. Students can limit searches to only those items physically held by the Library or a search can be done of the entire WorldCat database that encompasses millions of titles in libraries throughout the world. Items held by the University of Delaware Library appear at or near the top of the results display. Items not held by the Library can be requested via a link that automatically generates an Interlibrary Loan request form.

The Library also collaborates with a growing number of digital humanities programs involving graduate students.

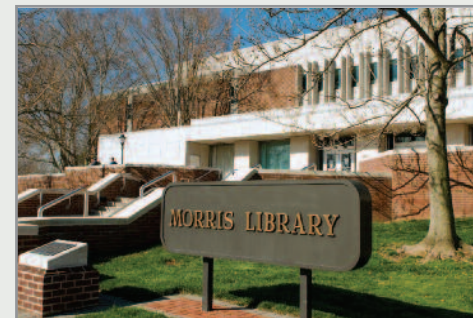
Databases

Dissertations and Theses

The *ProQuest Dissertations & Theses* database contains information on more than one million dissertations.
