About Maureen Corrigan

Maureen Corrigan is America's most trusted and beloved book critic. Her distinctive voice is at once incisive and accessible, like a well-read friend who always sends you home with a good book to read.

For more than 20 years, Corrigan has been the book critic for NPR's *Fresh Air*. She is also a columnist for *The Washington Post* and the critic-in-residence at Georgetown University where her courses are very popular. As a lecturer, she's been described as "brilliant," "hilarious," "passionate" and "eloquent." She is the author of two books: *Leave Me Alone I'm Reading* and *So We Read*

On: How the Great Gatsby Came to Be and Why it Endures, which was named one of the ten best books of the year by *Library Journal*.

Aside from her writings for *The Washington Post* and *The Village Voice*, Corrigan has also written reviews for *The New York Times*, *The Boston Globe* and *The Nation*. She is an associate editor and contributor to *Mystery and Suspense Writers* and the winner of the 1999 Edgar Award for Criticism. She has served as a juror for the Pulitzer Prize in Fiction.
