About Erica Armstrong Dunbar

Erica Armstrong Dunbar, Blue and Gold Distinguished Professor of Black American Studies and History at the University of Delaware, and 2016 winner of the Lorraine A. Williams



Leadership Award from the Association of Black Women Historians, will give the 2017 Faculty Lecture entitled *Never Caught: The Washingtons' Relentless Pursuit of Their Runaway Slave, Ona Judge*, sponsored by the University of Delaware Library Associates. Dunbar received her bachelor's degree from the University of Pennsylvania and her master's and doctoral degrees from Columbia University in New York. She is a recognized scholar whose work examines the lives of free and enslaved African American women in the early days of the United States.


Dunbar contributed to several documentaries, including *Philadelphia: The Great Experiment* and *The Abolitionists*, an American Experience production on PBS. She was appointed the first director of the Program in African American History

at the Library Company of Philadelphia in 2011; has been the recipient of Ford, Mellon and SSRC fellowships; and named Distinguished Lecturer of the Organization of American Historians.

Dunbar has written book chapters for *Women in Early America* and for *Women's Rights and Transatlantic Antislavery in the Era of Emancipation* and the article, "A Mental and Moral Feast: Reading, Writing, and Sentimentality in Black Philadelphia" for the *Journal of Women's History*. She is the author of the books, *A Fragile Freedom: African American Women and Emancipation in the Antebellum City*, and her most recent book, *Never Caught: The Washingtons' Relentless Pursuit of Their Runaway Slave, Ona Judge*.

Directions to Trabant University Center Garage

From the north: I-95 South to Delaware Exit 1-B, Route 896 North, and continue north on South College Avenue past the Bob Carpenter Sports/Convocation Center, the Delaware Stadium and the Field House until you reach central campus. Continue straight on South College Avenue past the Trabant University Center on the left. Turn left at the light onto Main Street and the Trabant University Center Garage will be on your left and after the Trabant University Center. The Morris Library is located at 181 S. College Avenue and the entrance is on The Green.

From the south: I-95 north to Maryland Exit 109B (towards, Newark, DE), Route 279 North (also called Route 2). Proceed on this road, which becomes Elkton Road, into Newark. Turn right onto West Park Place to South College Avenue. Make a left onto South College Avenue, continue on South College Avenue going past the Morris Library on the right and the Trabant University Center on the left. Turn left at the light onto Main Street and the Trabant University Center Garage will be on your left and after the Trabant University Center. The Morris Library is located at 181 S. College Avenue and the entrance is on The Green.

Directions to the Perkins Student Center Garage

From the north: I-95 South to Delaware Exit 1-B, Route 896 North, and continue north on South College Avenue past the Bob Carpenter Sports/Convocation Center, the Delaware Stadium, and the Field House until you reach Park Place Road. Turn right onto Park Place Road and then left onto Academy Street. The Perkins Student Center Garage is located at the intersection of Academy and Courtney Streets, adjacent to the Perkins Student Center. The Morris Library is located at 181 S.
