Monica McCormick has been appointed associate university librarian for scholarly publishing and research, effective August 1, 2017. In this role, McCormick will provide leadership for the design, development, management and support of current and emerging library-based digital initiatives, such as digital scholarship, scholarly communication and related programs. She also will provide strategic direction for the Library's scholarly publishing, including the University of Delaware Press and the developing journal publishing operation, and research management functions.

McCormick comes to us from the New York University (NYU) Libraries and Press where she was the program officer for digital scholarly publishing. She has held previous positions at North Carolina State University, the University of North Carolina and the Association of Research Libraries. Before becoming a librarian, she was acquiring editor in history at the University of California Press. McCormick earned her bachelor of arts in history from Carleton College and her master of science in library and information science from the University in North Carolina.
